Main interests are epidemiological and health service investigations focussing on mental illhealth and on challenging behaviour in people with intellectual developmental disorders across the lifespan. We are interested in patient and public engagement with science and have directly contributed as author/co-author to over 200 publications including original papers, book chapters and systematic reviews. Other roles include editorship of the Journal of Mental Health Research in Intellectual Disabilities, associate Director of the IASSIDD Academy for training and Education and visiting professorship at Ulster University.
