

## **Top Tips for Research Organisations**

- 1. Help prevent Researchfish emails from getting labelled as spam by 'white listing' <a href="mailto:admin@researchfish.com">admin@researchfish.com</a> and <a href="mailto:support@researchfish.com">support@researchfish.com</a>
- 2. Communicate with PI's help them to know what is required and to look out for invitations
- 3. Know where to get help Help & Support pages (https://app.researchfish.com/helpwiz)
- 4. Use Researchfish to monitor researchers' progress at your research organisation contact <a href="mailto:enquiries@researchfish.com">enquiries@researchfish.com</a> for help on how
- 5. If researchers link their ORCID to Researchfish then publications can move between the two sites.
