

## Adding an entry to the UK COVID-19 Public Involvement in Research database

## Where is the database?

The UK Covid-19 Public Involvement in Research database is hosted on the FutureNHS collaboration platform, within a workspace for the National Public Engagement Practitioners' Network.

The FutureNHS Collaboration platform is an online platform open to anyone working in of for health and social care. It has an active member base from many local, regional, and national organisations, and supports people to connect and collaborate more effectively.

The National Public Engagement Practitioners' Network workspace is a dedicated area of the FutureNHS Collaboration platform for public involvement and engagement staff working across the UK health and social care sector. It aims to offer relevant, high quality information, learning opportunities, and resources.

## How to add your network to the UK COVID-19 public involvement in research database

You will receive a separate email inviting you to join the National Public Engagement Practitioners' Network workspace on the FutureNHS Collaboration platform.

- 1. Please follow the instructions in the email to join the workspace. The registration form asks for some basic information when you register as a member (you can amend this later if you need to).
- 2. When you've accepted the FutureNHS invitation the National Public Engagement Practitioners Network will now appear as an option in the drop down list when you click on 'My Workspaces' on the top left of the page when you log onto the platform.

UK COVID-19 Public Involvement in Research Network
Guidance on adding information to the database
We are asking some questions about the demographic make up of public involvement groups around the UK so that we can match researchers with groups whose members are most likely to have lived experience relevant to their research. We are focusing on age and ethnicity because these factors are particularly relevant for COVID-19 research.
Please answer based on the current membership of your group, rather than on who the group is open to. E.g. if your group is open to children and young people but does not have any younger members, please do not select that box.
