










# **Data Collection**

• PR ranged from between 1-6 interviews each from a total of 22 interviews

Comfortable **Ethics** Environment **Steps to enhance** participation Safeguarding - Flexibility Voice recorder - Transportation Consent **Topic Guide** - No payment but lunch included - Supportive Confidentiality **Debrief Form** relationship with project researcher

# **Debrief Outcome**

#### Keeping it *simple*

*Silence* /nonimmediate response are ok

Using visual cues

# **STRATEGIES**



Giving *time* to respond

*Prompts* to explore responses

> Making a connection with

interviewee

Eye contact, be affirming and interested

Interview timing Repeating questions Seating


**Seating** was important



# **Data Validation**

5 peer researchers took part in validation

- Read interview transcripts
- Group discussion of themes
- Shown coding framework
- Generated themes
