Updates on the Researchfish Interface and Release Notes

A fresh user interface has been introduced by Researchfish, to improve accessibility, look and feel of the platform and make it more responsive depending on the device you are on. This new theme has been developed building on feedback from external user testing. A staged release is planned, that is currently opt in for all users and will be opt out by the end of 2022, with the old theme available until April 2023.

Further work to improve the user experience will be coming as we close the year with work on the navigation and Researcher submission experience. We are looking to improve how Funders manage email templates and to provide information to Researchers about what Researchfish has done to pre-populate data for them.

In e-Val, Search functionality will be extended to all remaining Funder administrators, and all Research Organisation Administrators. This functionality will take account of whether the administrator has full access or node-level access, and whether they have read-only or read-write access.

Researchfish Communications Workshop Update

In October we held a workshop with 8 of our funder customers to talk all things communications. Sincere thanks to those of you who attended and joined in the lively discussion. It was wonderful to see most of you in person for the first time in

so long! Since the workshop we've been busy working on some comms-related outputs that we hope will be useful. These include:

1. **Best practice in communications** – we want to ensure the best possible submission experience for our research community (and comms is a critical component of this), so we have compiled some Top tips for communicating with researchers.
2. **Roles and Responsibilities** – a brief overview of what each stakeholder is responsible for with regards to the Researchfish platform and submission periods
3. Updated version of the '**How the information is used by your funder**' document – this is available to users in the platform and you should also feel free to direct researchers to the Knowledgebase if they have questions on this topic.

All of the above documents are available on the Researchfish platform in the [Knowledgebase](#) (remember you need your log in details). We will continue to use these in our training and submission preparation sessions with stakeholders. Please ask us if you can't find something you want – we are eager to work with you to ensure that all communications received by researchers contribute to an improved researcher experience.
